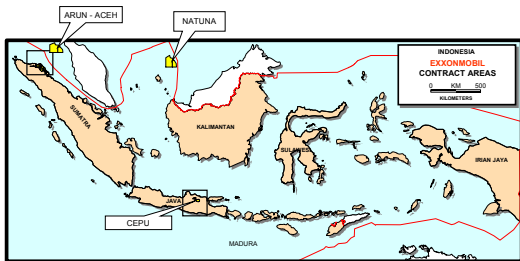

- **Immediate Response**
  - Crisis Management Center in Banda Aceh (employee & families)
  - Availability of private airstrip to aid organizations
  - Charter of aircraft to fly in supplies and medical personnel
  - Provision of heavy machinery and water supply to support relief effort
- **Financial Assistance**

➢ ExxonMobil Employees*	\$3M
➢ ExxonMobil one to one match	\$3M

### AFRICA HEALTH INITIATIVE

- In Africa, Malaria kills some 3000 children everyday
- Over the past 5 years, ExxonMobil has been working with a growing number of partners to advance Roll Back Malaria
- In 2005, \$10million awarded to support international and local health organizations and programs to:
  - Support Research & Development for new drugs, vaccines and health care delivery
  - Promote education and prevention
  - Expand opportunities for improved diagnosis and treatment
